# **Business School Postgraduate Research Support Scheme Definitions (2024)**

## Allocation criteria:

#### **Eligibility requirements:**

- 1. Candidates must meet general PRSS Eligibility Requirements.
- 2. Applicants seeking conference funding must be presenting a paper or poster that the candidate has contributed to at the conference.
- 3. Claims for computer hardware will be capped at \$1000 AUD.

#### Selection criteria:

- 1. Performance to date
- 2. Detail of evidence submitted with the application for funding e.g. quotations for costs, acceptance of conference paper
- 3. Candidates who have not had previous funding will have priority over those who have
- 4. Evidence of the extent to which the funding is essential to the progression of the candidate's research degree

#### **Business School PRSS Committee constitution:**

The Business School PRSS awarding committee will consist of the Director of Doctoral Studies, a Postgraduate Research Coordinator from each of the two discipline clusters, and a HDR candidate nominee. The committee is supported by the HDR Training Coordinator.

Discipline clusters:

**Cluster 1)** Institute of Transport & Logistics Studies, Business Analytics, Accounting, Finance, International Business

**Cluster 2)** Strategy, Innovation & Entrepreneurship, Work and Organisational Studies, Business Information Systems, Marketing

## Draft statement on managing Conflicts of Interest within the Business School PRSS Committee:

'University Staff Members, including members of the PRSS committee are obliged to avoid, consistently with the terms of the <a href="External Interests Policy">External Interests Policy</a> real or perceived conflicts of interest between their personal or private interests or duties and their duties to the University.

Where a PRSS committee member has a supervisory relationship with the applicant, the member in question will declare this to the rest of the panel and step aside from discussions related to that candidate.'
