FIELDWORK RULES & GUIDELINES

Australia Awards are prestigious awards offered by the Australian Government to the next generation of global leaders for development.

Australia Awards Scholarship (AAS) students are entitled to a limited amount of fieldwork cost entitlements.

The University of Sydney's **International Sponsorships** team administers fieldwork entitlement on behalf of its AAS students, ensuring equity, transparency and good use of public money.

Fieldwork entitlement is available to students enrolled in a Master's by research, a PhD or a Master's by coursework program which has a research component, where fieldwork is a compulsory component; Scholarship fieldwork entitlement can only be used once all other relevant funding sources provided by the University have been exhausted; Fieldwork must be undertaken in Australia or in the student's country. In exceptional cases, fieldwork undertaken in another country within the region will be considered by DFAT; **ACADEMIC SUPPORT** Fieldwork must be undertaken during the duration of student's scholarship period; The maximum period which may be approved for fieldwork is 12 months; Fieldwork must not result in an extension to the scholarship; For up to date scholarship policy, please refer to the latest scholarship Handbook: http://dfat.gov.au/about-us/publications/Documents/aus-awards-scholarships-policyhandbook.pdf International Sponsorships team reserves the right to administer student's fieldwork entitlement on **PLEASE NOTE** a case-by-case basis, at its own discretion, and in line with the University's contract with DFAT.
