

FACULTY OF SCIENCE – UNIVERSITY VETERINARY TEACHING HOSPITALS PREMIUM LOADINGS PROVISIONS 2023

1 Purpose and application

- (1) These provisions apply within the University Veterinary Teaching Hospitals (“the teaching hospitals”) in the Sydney School of Veterinary Science (SSVS) within the Faculty of Science.
- (2) These provisions apply to Veterinarians employed as professional HEO staff within the teaching hospitals.
- (3) Under these provisions, for any rostered shift that includes hours worked outside 7.00am and 7.00pm:
 - (a) From Monday to Saturday, where currently a common shift loading of 15% is applied, an additional premium shift loading of:
 - (i) \$30.82 per hour for HEO 5
 - (ii) \$34.25 per hour for HEO 6-9 will also be applied.
 - (b) On Sunday, where currently a shift loading of 75% is paid, an additional premium shift loading of:
 - (i) \$15.01 per hour for HEO 5
 - (ii) \$16.88 per hour for HEO 6-9 will also be applied
 - (c) On public holidays, a common shift loading of 250% applies and no additional premium loadings will apply.
- (4) These shift loadings only apply to the rostered shifts. Any overtime will be calculated separately according to the relevant clauses of the Enterprise Agreement.
- (5) For casual staff, these loadings are in addition to the casual loading offered to staff as per the Enterprise Agreement.
- (6) These loadings have been designed to offer Veterinarians working in the teaching hospitals a comparative market rate for work performed after-hours. These may be altered or removed in response to future market conditions.
